<p>ABS</p>	<p><u>Absent</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The student has not handed in the assignment. • The student has an excused absence on either the day the assignment was given or the day the assignment was graded. <p><i>The assignment will contribute no points to a student's grade (like a zero) until it is handed in. One week following the student's return to class, if the assignment still hasn't been submitted, the grade will revert to NHI.</i></p>
<p>NG</p>	<p><u>Not Graded</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The assignment was not graded. (Homework assignments are graded randomly.) <p><i>The assignment will not contribute points to a student's grade, but is not counted as a zero either (it is dropped entirely when calculating the grade average). It is not considered "missing" or "not handed in", and will allow students to qualify for Cotton Cash bonuses.</i></p>
