Abbreviated Rules and Expectations

- I understand that I will have homework almost every night, and I need to read and take notes on the assigned section(s) before coming to class. Homework, pre-reading (notes,) and class notes will be checked randomly.
- When the bell rings, I must be in my assigned seat, with homework, pencils, eraser, calculator, textbook, paper, and other required supplies.
- To get credit for any work (Homework, Quizzes, etc.) I must show all my work. (Examples of “acceptable work” can be seen in daily class notes, examples, etc.)
- Credit will only be granted for work completed in **pencil**. I will follow the formatting conventions described in class (such as headers, labeling, single-sided work, etc.)
- I will not always be permitted to use a calculator. I may not share a calculator during quizzes or tests, if I do it will be considered cheating, and grounds for failure on the assignment.
- There may be both “pop” and planned quizzes, throughout the year.
- I must maintain my class notebook (3-ring binder, 1” minimum). All handouts must be 3-hole punched and organized in my notebook, along with all class notes, homework, quizzes, and tests. Spiral bound paper or other paper with ragged edges is unacceptable.
- I must be on time to class, I will receive detentions on the 3rd and all subsequent tardies in a quarter. If the teacher permits it, I may cash-in Cotton Cash in exchange for a detention.
- I may not use the restroom, water fountain, etc. unless I choose to spend Cotton Cash.
- I will show respect for my teacher and classmates, I will be quiet and attentive in class, and will not speak when the teacher is speaking, or when the teacher has recognized another student and he/she is speaking.
- I understand that grades will vary each quarter, but will (in general) follow the schedule below:
 - ~50% - Tests
 - ~25% - Quizzes (scheduled & “pop”)
 - ~20% - Daily Work (Homework, Classwork)
 - ~5% - Notebook (*may only be checked 1st quarter*)
 - A - 90%-100%
 - B - 80% - 89%
 - C - 70% - 79%
 - D - 60% - 69%
 - F - 59% or lower
- After homework is two days late, no credit will be granted. For any credit to be granted for late homework, I must present it to the teacher, the teacher will not seek me out for late homework.
- I understand the make-up policies of this class. I will have “a day for a day” extension for assignments given in my absence. In short, if I am absent (excused) and miss a quiz or a test, I must make it up the day I return. If I miss a test and the day prior, or two days prior to a test, I must make up the test within two days of returning to class. I am encouraged to makeup tests during my study hall or after school, and whenever possible I should contact Mrs. Cotton ahead of time to schedule my makeup quiz or test. Immediately upon returning to class, I will arrange a time to makeup the quiz/test with Mrs. Cotton. If I fail to make arrangements within a week of returning to class I will be given a zero for the test/quiz. If there are extenuating circumstances, or if I miss more than two days of class in a row, I should make special arrangements with Mrs. Cotton.
- I am expected to maintain an A/B average in this AA class.
