Mapwork: China/Southeast Asia

Directions: using an atlas and maps on pages 266, 274, 302 & 305 do the following:

(If Mapwork is obtained off Homelink page, then print two copies of “Asia” map and label one “Map 1” and the other “Map 2”, also use map of “Southeast Asia” and label as Map 3)

A) On Map 1:

- 1) label and locate: Japan Sea, East China Sea, South China Sea, Bay of Bengal, Yellow River, Yangtze River, His River, Gobi Desert, Kunlun Mts., Himalaya Mts.
- 2) Draw in: Great Wall and Grand Canal (ID on legend)
- 3) Draw in borders for Sui and color.
4. Draw in border for Tang and color.
5. Locate and label: Loyang, Changan, Tunhuang, Khotan, Kashgar, Nanking, Hangzhou, Kaifeng
6. Make a color coded legend.

B) On Map 2:

- 1) Draw in borders for Song Dynasty and color.
- 2) Draw in borders for Southern Song and color.
- 3) Locate, draw in and color the “Three Kingdoms” (Korea)
- 4) Make a color coded legend.

C) On Map 3:

- 1) Locate and Label: Indian Ocean, South China Sea, Hainan Island, Gulf of Thailand, Andaman Sea, Mekong River, Red River, His River, Gulf of Tonkin, Yangtze River, Sumatra, Java, Borneo, Celebes, Japan, Taiwan, Philippines
- 2) Draw in borders for Nam Viet and color.
- 3) Make a color coded legend.

D) Japan Map

1. Locate the four main islands of Japan (Hokkaido, Honshu, Shikoku and Kyushu). Color using a different color for each island.
2. Locate and label: Sea of Japan, East China Sea, Pacific Ocean, Korea Strait, Japanese Alps, Chugoku Mountains, Ou Mountains, Hidaka Mountains, Mount Fuji, Okinawa
3. Locate and label the Japanese capitals: Heian, Nara
4. Make a color coded legend.
