GENERAL TIPS

- Entries are in alphabetical order.
Double-space within and between entries.
 - The first line of each entry begins at the left margin. The second line (if needed) is indented five spaces.
 - If you use a source not listed here, consult the *MLA Handbook for Writers of Research Papers* (Ref 808.027 Gi) or ask a librarian for assistance.
 - If you cannot find a date, use the abbreviation n.d. (no date). If you cannot find a page, use n.p. (no page).
 - Do not label the entries with the type of source (e.g. Magazine).
 - If the URL of a Database is impractically long and complicated, use the URL of the site's search page (to the .com)
